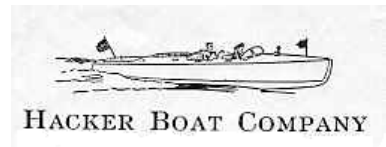

HACKER 26 STERLING



The *STERLING* model is named in honor of the Sterling Engine Company of Buffalo, New York. Sterling engines were installed in many of Hacker's early runabouts—including Hacker's 1914 Gold Cup racer *Buffalo Enquirer*. The *STERLING* includes eight more inches on its beam than on a comparably sized Hacker Runabout. Note the beautifully crafted floor vents—a feature common on Greavette runabouts of Canadian fame. The *STERLING* with its modified barrel back tumblehome and its blond colored center and cover boards on its decks and its angled bow and stern flags are the personification of a 2010 version of a 1940s classic.

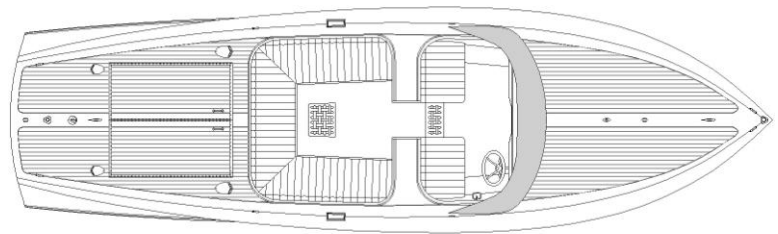
